## 2012-2013 Responsibilities of New Covenant School Parents

1. We the parent(s) or guardian(s) of \_\_\_\_\_, accepting God's responsibility which says, "Train up a child in the way he should go and when he is old, he will not depart from it" (Proverbs 22:6), purpose to set a model through daily times of personal devotion, family devotion, and regular attendance as a family to the Christian church of our choice where we serve as members in good standing.
2. We have examined and agree with the Statement of Faith, Mission, Objectives, and Philosophy of New Covenant School and desire the school to work with us in the total education of our children.
3. We pledge to meet all attendance requirements at school wide meetings, teacher conferences, and parent meetings.
4. We pledge our loyalty to the aims and the ideals of the school and will bring any and all questions and criticisms directly to our child's teacher in order that they may be properly dealt with by those in authority. Appropriate suggestions and input to improve our school will be directed to the school Headmaster, along with questions or concerns about the vision and mission of the school.
5. We pledge that we and our child will abide by the academic, dress, and disciplinary standards of New Covenant School. We recognize that the school reserves the right to dismiss, suspend, or otherwise discipline any student who does not adhere to the standards of New Covenant School.
6. We agree to take ownership of our child's instructional education through regular meetings with teachers, assisting our children in homework or after school help if needed, and being directly involved in developing a scope and sequence for meeting graduation requirements.
7. We agree to pay our tuition and fees when due. We understand that a \$50 late fee will be added to accounts not received by the 10<sup>th</sup> of each month. A student whose family falls two or more months behind may be dismissed from the school. All accounts must be paid in full for the current term for report cards to be issued or for transcripts to be sent to other schools or given to parents. We understand that tuition and fees, once submitted, are non-refundable.
8. We pledge willingness to assist the school in carrying out its objectives, which may involve specific teaching duties, planning, supervision, field trips, events etc.
9. Understanding that Senior graduation is our highest ceremony and the culmination of the vision and mission at work, we agree to make every effort to attend the Senior graduation at the end of the year to witness the vision and support the hard work of our most dedicated families and students.

We understand that this Family Commitment Contract is a binding financial agreement for the full payment of tuition and fees due. We agree to pay all tuition and fees on time. Where a change due to family relocation to another city or state occurs or dismissal from school by NCS becomes necessary, we understand that tuition charges will be payable through the month of departure.
